But: $\pi\alpha\iota\delta\iota\alpha$ (end of 13) – younger children

He says (v.12) to the ones (in general):

- B. "your sins are forgiven you" (12) (a believer's standing before God) Now to the younger children he says:
- C. "you have known the Father" (13b) know little but the basics; they know they're saved, with a lot to learn.


BIBLE SPEAKS OF 2 KINDS OF SPIRITUAL INFANTS:
