I John 2:28-29

WE ALL LIKE TO BE PREPARED...

ARE YOU ALWAYS READY FOR WHAT LIFE THROWS AT YOU?

- We should endeavor to do that...
- We plan for emergencies.
- We plan for special events.
- We plan for the unexpected.
- <u>We should plan</u> for the coming of the Lord!

JOHN BEGINS A NEW SECTION:

- Hinge section between the previous and the new section (chapter 3ff)
- The tip is the "and now" of verse 28
- A new paragraph in Greek
- Hinges the "abiding" [used 10x] of chapter 2; to the new section chapter 3 where John focuses on Sonship via the new birth [used 9x] from this point.
- Also there is a theme of confidence from this point...(2:29-4:19)
- So, in our lives we can be <u>sure</u>, (confident) of a lot of things...

JOHN GIVES US 2 THINGS WE CAN BE SURE OF

I. We are sure of heaven (v. 28)

John uses 2 subjunctive verbs:

 $\sigma \kappa \omega \mu \epsilon \nu$ – "we may have" [confidence!] and \ldots

αισχυντωμεν – "be shamed" with the negative: μη "not"

Now there are 2 messages here:

- message to believers
- ➡ message to unbelievers
- A. Message to believers

<u>First</u>: "Abide in Him" - $\mu\epsilon\nu\omega$ [imperative] "to stay, to remain" <u>Second</u>: As we are sure of heaven, it will produce 2 reactions:

- 1. <u>We have confidence!</u> assurance, poise
- 2. We will not be ashamed!

(Over)

B. Message to unbelievers:

Are you ready?

Or would you be ashamed at all the opportunities you had to receive Christ?

II. We are sure of righteous living (vs. 29)

A. Because God is righteous

2 words translated "know" are 2 different Greek words:

First: $0i\delta\alpha$ – sense of perceiving, understanding an absolute truth, because I'm, (you're) told.

Second: $\gamma t v o \omega \sigma \kappa \omega$ – to know **by** experience

B. Because man <u>can</u> be righteous because He (God) is righteous!

CONCLUSION:

- Are you righteous and ready for the Lord to come?
- Jesus is coming, are you confident, or will you shrink away?
- Are you sure your saved? There are only 2 places to go when we meet the Lord. Where will you spend eternity?
