  - Shun the world it's passing away
  - o Watch out for antichrist's (false teachers) among us

# And Now you have power! 3 Facts about power:

## I. It's from the Holy Spirit (v. 20, 27)

A. Anointing of the Holy One

– this word translated "anointing (unction)"  $\chi\rho\iota\sigma\mu\alpha$  literally means ointment or oil. Used in the Old Testament ritually for sanctifying the tabernacle and things in it. Also, showed God's power for/with/on a new king of Israel/Judah as they were anointed.

#### CHRIST WAS THE ONE GIVING THE HOLY SPIRIT:

John 20:21-22 - the resurrected Christ gives the H.S.

Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit." **Given** here to the apostles, later at Pentecost **given** to all believers.

### II. It gives you the truth (vs. 21, 24-25)

- A. You know (21)
- > 2 Corinthians 2:10
- B. "no lie is of the truth" (v. 21b) meaning what they would say: "my way isn't false, it's just another way of looking at it." or "I'm looking at it from a different angle"

### III. Reveals that the antichrist's are liars (22-23; 26)

- A. Any that deny Christ, and the Father (23b; 22b)
- B. It's why he has written (26)

#### **CONCLUSION:**

- Christians: This will give you confidence in the truth.
- The more you know, the more you let the Word and the Holy Spirit saturate your soul; the wiser, the more deciphering and discerning you will be. His power will benefit you!
