### SO, BECAUSE GOD DID FOR US, AND GAVE ALL FOR US...

It is **impossible** and **unthinkable** that true believers would continue in "devil like" behavior. So, we should **do** our best, **be** our best for Him!

# SIN SHOULD BE THE EXCEPTION, NOT THE RULE, JOHN EXPLAINS BY STATING 4 THINGS:

- I. He that is righteous is righteous (v. 7)
  - A. Is in Christ (v. 6)
  - B. He will be like the Father (v. 7b) and there is no neutral ground!!
- II. He that is sinning is evil (v. 8)
  - A. Of the devil (Isaiah 14:12-14; Ezekiel 28:12-17)
  - B. The reason Jesus came (v. 8 purpose)
- III. He that is a true believer wins the battles (v. 9)
  - A. He is born of God (perfect verb)

Ephesians 2:10 "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works..."

### For we are HIS workmanship, masterpiece...

**Workmanship** – Greek word comes from the word poem (lyrics to a song). So Jesus Christ can write, (is writing) the song, the story of your life...

See, if we write our own story - it's empty, meaningless.

If we let God write our story... in whatever vocation, in whatever He calls you to do – it's beautiful! Make your life <u>His</u> workmanship, beautiful artwork, poem, song.

B. He (who is born of God) has the ability, and will be victorious!

## IV. He that is a Child of the devil does not fight the battles (v.10)

- A. Shows in their lifestyles (10a)
- B. Shows in their love (10b)

## CONCLUSION:

- So, evaluate your life...
- Are you saved? Born again?
- Are you in the family of God? Are you righteous?
- If not, you are in the family of the devil. It's either one or the other.
