John covers this topic in verses 11-18. 3 POINTS JOHN MAKES HERE: <u>ABOUT LOVE</u>

I. We know God's love (v. 16) A. That He, (God) loves us Everyone knows: "LOVE IS ACTION"

I John 3:16-18



John 3:16 – For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten (unique) Son, that whosoever believeth...

1 John 3:16 – [here] Both talk about God's love toward us, and the evidence of true love!

 B. Because of His sacrifice Does John really expect his readers to die for others? How could any believer attempt to imitate what Jesus did? John 15:12-17
