THAT POWERFUL LOVE

We sang about love this morning.

Do we really understand it? Do we really understand *unconditional* love?

Also: A lot of things that we call love don't rise to the level of what love is and what love does.

LOVE IS NOT DEFINED BY EMOTIONS!

It is **not** touchy, feely.

- It is not a group hug.
- It is **not** warm puppies, snuggles.
- It's not closeness.

These are all descriptions of feelings!

These are all normal and great and special, but...

IN OUR TEXT, 1 JOHN 4:7-21, JOHN TALKS ABOUT "LOVE"

Explains it more than the other 2 times in this letter:

- briefly in chapter 2 as evidence of our fellowship with God.
- then in chapter 3 love was evidence of our sonship with God; that we love one another.
- > both instances above are brief compared to these 15 verses
- \blacktriangleright where the Greek term $\alpha\gamma\alpha\pi\epsilon$ is used 27 times

THE SOURCE OF LOVE IS GOD. TWO FACTS:

- I. God is Love (vs. 8b, 9, 10, 16, 19)
 - A. He defines love
 - B. God is love; not love is God

II. God demonstrates love (9-10, 14)

- A. Sent His only Son, Jesus
- B. Sent Him to be the propitiation means to appease His wrath; to make payment

CONCLUSION:

- Have you accepted God's love?
- Do you understand, Christian, that God is love?
- God's love reaches down to us. Why?
- Who can understand His love?!
